WHAT WORK IS HAPPENING HERE?

Over the next few months, WECC will relocate the access to the pedestrian bridge from the south-east to the south-west side. This work is necessary to prepare for the road realignment and extraction shaft work. It will begin in late January on the south side of Eglinton Ave West, just west of the intersection at Scarlett Road (please refer to the area map on page one). This work includes:

- Removing trees from the west side of the pedestrian bridge
- Temporarily relocating the multi-use path to accommodate for construction activities
- Building the new west ramp to the pedestrian bridge
- Removing the existing concrete ramp

The road realignment will begin after this work is complete. Another notice with more details will be shared at that time.

HOURS OF WORK

• Construction crews will work Monday to Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Extended hours may be required on occasion.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work on the pedestrian bridge access is expected to be completed in March 2022.
- Nearby residents can expect to hear minimal noise from equipment, such as hauling trucks, excavators, dozers, and generators.

TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS

- There will be no Eglinton Ave West lane closures during this work.
- Pedestrian detours will be required to ensure safe work sites and the safety of those travelling through the area.
- The multi-use path on the south side of Eglinton Ave West will be temporarily diverted to the sidewalk south of pedestrian bridge.
- All ramp and pedestrian connections to the bridge will be maintained.

The information provided above is anticipated based on the current construction schedule and is subject to change due to schedule changes, weather or unforeseen circumstances.
